

INSTRUCTIONS FOR SUBMISSION OF CONTRIBUTIONS, PEER-REVIEW AND PUBLICATION PROCESS

1. **Submission of Contributions:** Proposals of contributions (Articles or Reports) can be submitted to the Editors or to the Editorial Boards sending an e-mail to: coordination.iuspublicum@gmail.com.

The contributions must be drafted according to the Review format.

2. **Peer-review process and publication:** The contributions (Articles or Reports) are evaluated by the Editors and the Editorial Boards. They decide if the contribution meets the quality standards to go through the full review process according to the aims and scope of the Review. If this preliminary assessment is negative, the Authors will be informed. Otherwise, the contributions are submitted to a double-blind peer-review process by the Editors.

The peer-review is carried out on grounds of: *Academic value, significance of the topic and contribution to existing knowledge (originality and novelty); Intelligibility to Public Law scholars of other legal systems; Completeness of sources; Soundness of methods, completeness of reasoning and evidence supports conclusion; Effectiveness (the issue is clearly formulated); Organisation of the paper; Clarity of the writing style; Overall merit.*

Overall recommendation is given to the Authors: Publication as it is; Publication after acknowledgement of the suggestions; Not yet ready for publication.

The peer-review process ends in no more than two months.
